Please be sure your block is a full 10 ½ inches. Sign your name and Rotary district number in the lower left hand corner leaving room for seam allowance.

We also welcome any donations of lap or crib sized quilts of any design, as well as handmade items which are knitted, crocheted, woven, cross stitched, etc. Any design is great. There will be someone at the booth to receive them when the House of Friendship opens. Be sure to include a note or label to identify the fabric artist.
